


- and both Bushes have stayed at the hotel.

Airport Transportation Options Local

- Taxi Average fare \$20.00 per trip
- Limousine service can be obtained by contacting the concierge at (804) 649-4615. Fees vary.
- Jefferson guests coming to the hotel from the airport should go to the Groome Transportation booth at the airport located outside of the baggage claim area
- Arriving at the hotel, the guest should go to the concierge desk and fill out a Groome Transportation voucher. The charge will then be applied to the guest's room bill.
- Guests going to the airport should contact the concierge in advance for transportation arrangements.

Local Transportation

- The Jefferson offers complimentary transportation to all downtown destinations including the financial district, convention center, the capital, Carytown shopping district and the Shockoe Slip/Shockoe Bottom entertainment districts
- Advance reservations are required and may be made through the concierge desk.
- The service is available from 7:00am to 11:00pm daily with last call at 10:45pm
